What to see in Umbria - favourite spots from the VocMos team

Perugia

Perugia is the capital city of Umbria and offers a wide variety of things to do, including attractions such as churches, architecture and art, as well as shopping opportunities, and a diverse selection of restaurants and bars. Plenty of events take place in Perugia every month as well.

Assisi

Assisi, the town of Saint Francis, stretches out along the slopes of Monte Subasio. The long roads which sit at a reasonably high altitude, cross the town and open onto the large piazzas in front of the Cathedrals. In 2000 Assisi with its Historic centre, cathedrals and churches together with almost the entire municipal territory were declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



What to see in Umbria

Spello

Also called the city of flowers and art, Spello has a diverse offering of art and culture, and is known for its narrow, beautiful streets filled with flowers put up by the locals. Once a year, during the "Infiorata di Spello", the town turns into an exhibition of flower art spread on the streets and piazzas of Spello.

Spoletto

Spoletto is a captivating destination offering a seamless blend of ancient charm and modern delights. Marvel at the majestic medieval architecture as you stroll through its winding streets and explore the well-preserved Roman theater and the impressive Spoleto Cathedral. Immerse yourself in the cultural tapestry of the town by attending the renowned Festival dei Due Mondi, a world-class event celebrating music, dance, and art.

Trasimeno Lake

What to see in Umbria

Monti Sibillini National Park

Most well-known for the so-called Fiorita, a time in early summer when the flowers bloom and create a polychrome mosaic of petals and leaves, here in the heart of Umbria, the mountains can rise above 2000 metres of altitude. Consisting of 70,000 hectares, the National Park is a true treasure trove of biodiversity due to the alternating presence of wetlands in the valleys, thick forests and wonderful plateaus.

Activities and services in the national park include bike rental, excursions on horseback, guided tours and hiking, 8 downhill slopes, a snowpark, a toboggan run and bobsleds. Other sports available are mountain climbing, gliding and paragliding. Finally, there is also the possibility to try your hand at rafting and canyoning.

Foraging (2 hours)

Activities - Private winetastings

We have direct connections to the most interesting wineries in the region, we can offer made-to-measure wine tours, and private tastings at one of the following wineries we offer the wine in our restaurant from:

Andrea Pilar

On the next hill, a 20-minute drive. Tasting is usually held by one of the winemaker-family members. Take your time and try the wines from both the classical line and the new, biological line.

Collecapretta

is approximately a 1-hour drive away. Their winemaking process follows natural cycles and has a total absence of herbicides, pesticides and weeding, resulting in absolutely unique natural wines.



Activities - Private winetastings

Chiesa del Carmine

is approximately a 40-minute drive away. Multiple options for tastings paired with small bites by the talented kitchen. Guests are given a map to explore the surroundings of the Vinyard. Chiesa del Carmine makes wine, olive oil and has plenty of land for truffles.

Agri Segretum

is approximately a 1-hour drive away. Producers of wine, olive oil, ceramics and glass. Requires prior booking for tasting. Two options for tastings, duration varying from 1 hour to 1.5 hours.



Activities - Private winetastings

Azienda Agraria Scacciadiavoli

In this enchanting farm, located in Montefalco, around 1 hour drive from Vocabolo Moscatelli, you can enjoy different wine tastings in particular their well known Sagrantino walking through their old cellars in the immersed beautiful umbrian landscapes.

Cantina Fongoli

The Fongoli company was founded by Decio Fongoli in the early 1900s, when he took over a property made up of several farms, located in the centre of the Montefalco wine-making area. The winery now run by his nephews Decio and Angelo since 1999. The property covers about 35 hectares in a single body, 23 of which are vineyards managed entirely according to biodynamic principles.



Activities - Private winetastings

Antica Azienda Agricola Paolo Bea Vignaiolo in Montefalco

This spectacular winery is approximately a 1-hour drive away from Vocabolo Moscatelli. A family business with the following philosophy: "nature should be observed, listened to and integrated, not dominated. Wine is not made by man but generated by nature!"

Pomario Winery

Half an hour drive from here, this winery is perfectly located in the middle of a valley nearby Piegara, immersed into the green hills of this southern area of Perugia. They produce organic wines of different types and there is the possibility to arrange also cooking classes.



Activities

Chocolate Factory "Casa del Cioccolato Perugina"

A few kilometres away from Perugia's town centre, you'll be able to discover the secrets of chocolate. Possibility for a tour, starting at the Historic Museum, including a chocolate tasting stop and finally arriving at the heart of the factory.

In addition, Scuola del Cioccolato offers courses and workshops in chocolate-making techniques.

Fondazione Burri in Città di Castello

The Foundation, established by Maestro Alberto Burri, possesses the most comprehensive collection of works by the artist, housed in two permanent exhibition venues.

The venue in Palazzo Albizzini was opened to the public in 1981 and includes approximately 130 works by Alberto Burri from 1948 to 1989, arranged chronologically in twenty rooms.

The venue of the former Tobacco Dryhouses was opened in July 1990 and houses 128 works from 1970 to 1993. Three monumental sculptures are located in the outdoor spaces. All the works were selected and placed by the painter himself.



Seasonal activities in Umbria

Umbria Jazz

"It is the place to be at this time of year." Umbria Jazz is the most important Italian jazz music festival and one of the most important and renowned in the world. Founded in 1973 by Carlo Pagnotta, the festival takes place annually in Perugia in July.

The natural blooming of Castelluccio di Norcia

During the natural flowering stimulated by the placid late spring climate, the Castelluccio plateau is transformed into an explosion of colours, a natural spectacle that can be admired from late May to mid-July. Gentians, daffodils, poppies and many other flowers dye the meadows in bright colours.

Festa del Bosco in Montone

At the end of October, the historic village of Montone, one of the most beautiful in Italy, hosts the Festa del Bosco, one of the most evocative autumn events in Umbria that valorises small native productions. Markets, tastings, excursions, art, games, music and cultural insights will give a magical touch to the location.



White Truffle National Exhibition

White gold animates the streets and squares of the historic centre of Città di Castello. Here, in the heart of Umbria, taste & passion, experimentation & innovation, culture & tradition are the protagonists of the annual National Exhibition of the Fine White Truffle.



Seasonal activities in Umbria

Arezzo Christmas Market

Ferris wheel, traditional Christmas markets, light installations, Santa Clause's house and many other attractions await you in the Arezzo Christmas Village. Experience the most magical and awaited event of the year while discovering of the most beautiful cities in Italy.



Christmas in Montepulciano

With a short drive to Tuscany, the Montepulciano Christmas market can be reached. It is one of the largest Christmas markets in Italy, with over 60 wooden houses for Christmas shopping and many attractions for the whole family. Inside the market, it will be possible to taste local specialties.

Luci sul Trasimeno

Luci Sul Trasimeno is a special Christmas celebration with a unique spectacle of the largest Christmas tree in the world on the water. During the Christmas period, Castiglione del Lago is transformed into a true city of Christmas, with over 40 days of shows, attractions and entertainment for the young and the old.

Christmas Tree in Gubbio

The Christmas Tree, positioned at the base of Mount Ingino, the natural background of the medieval town of Gubbio, is formed by various types of lights that create an absolutely unique chromatic effect: more than 300 green coloured lights outline the shape of a Christmas tree that is more than 650 meters high with the center filled with more than 400 multi-coloured lights.
