

# Embarkation/Disembarkation Requirements

## CARIBBEAN ISLANDS



### Aruba

- ED Card: All visitors spending more than 24 hours in Aruba are required to complete the online Embarkation and Disembarkation (ED) Card form prior to arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required for the duration of your stay.
- Sustainability Fee: A \$20 Sustainability Fee is collected upon arrival.



### Dominican Republic (DR)

- Tourist Card: Visitors must purchase a tourist card upon arrival, costing \$10 USD.
- Passport: A valid passport is required for entry.



### Mexico

- Tourist Card (FMM): Visitors are issued a Forma Migratoria Múltiple (FMM) upon arrival, which is free for stays up to 7 days; longer stays may require a fee.
- Passport: A valid passport is necessary for entry.



### Bahamas

- Immigration Card: Visitors must complete an immigration card upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required.



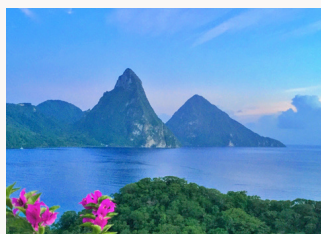
### Jamaica

- Immigration Form: An immigration form is provided and must be completed upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required and must remain valid for at least six months beyond your final date of travel.



### Barbados

- Embarkation/Disembarkation Card: Visitors must complete this card upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is necessary for entry.



### Saint Lucia

- Arrival Form: An arrival form is provided and must be completed upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required.



### Turks and Caicos

- Immigration Form: An immigration form is provided and must be completed upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required and must remain valid for at least six months beyond your final date of travel.



### Saint Kitts and Nevis

- Arrival Form: An arrival form is provided and must be completed upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required.



### Antigua and Barbuda

- Embarkation/Disembarkation Card: Visitors must complete this card upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required and must remain valid for at least six months beyond your final date of travel.



### Curacao

- Digital Immigration Card (DI Card): All international visitors to Curaçao are required to complete the Digital Immigration Card (DI Card) within 7 days prior to departure. This mandatory card can be filled out online at the official portal.
- Passport: A valid passport is required and must remain valid for at least six months beyond your final date of travel.



### Saint Martin

- Embarkation/Disembarkation Card: Visitors must complete this card upon arrival.
- Passport: A valid passport is required.
