







Non-profit conservation and community development partner in the Greater Kruger National Park region in South Africa. Through dedicated conservation efforts, the Singita Lowveld Trust contributes to Singita's 100-year purpose to preserve large areas of African wilderness for future generations.



Children in the Wilderness is a non-profit supported by Wilderness, focusing on sustainable conservation through education and leadership development for children in Africa. The program helps rural children understand the importance of conservation and prepares them to be future custodians of Africa's wilderness and wildlife. This is done through Eco-Club programs at local schools, camps at Wilderness and partner sites, and various community initiatives like school nutrition, village upliftment, and scholarship programs.



Great Plains' conservation efforts trace back to the early days of protecting wilderness. The focus is on preserving entire ecosystems to safeguard wildlife. By identifying threatened areas near national parks and reserves, we acquire rights to convert land into protected areas supported by photographic tourism, replacing hunting or agricultural land. Managing around 1,000,000 acres in Botswana, Kenya, and Zimbabwe, Great Plains implements innovative conservation and community projects in partnership with local communities.
